

Hello My Friend:

The Lower Muskogee Creek Tribe would love for you to join us as a vendor for our annual pow wow and school days. The pow wow begins Friday, October 21st and will run through Sunday, October 23rd. The pow wow is opened to the public at 5 PM, Friday, October 20th. School Days will be held Thursday, October 20th and Friday, October 21st. Last year we taught Creek history and culture to approximately 700, 2nd, 4th and 8th graders. This year we expect approximately 1000, if not more. Hopefully, the 4th graders will be attending again from Panama City, FL, my hometown.

The price quoted (\$50) is for the event whether, you stay for four days or for one day the price is \$50 for a 10X20 foot canopy, **for anything larger there will be an additional cost, depending on the size of the site needed.** If you need electricity there is an additional \$15 fee. A \$25 auction item will be collected from each vendor on Saturday before the auction.

Please no garage sale, yard sale or junk yard items. In 2014 there was a problem with junk being sold. We listened to you guys and solved the problem. **NO JUNK WILL BE SOLD, PERIOD!**

We look forward to seeing you. If you know of any other traders that would like to join us, please feel free to contact us at the email or telephone number listed below. Most of our vendors are by invitation only, so we trust you guys to know who is right for Tama.
